 - 6: Make it easy for the emergency services - in the contacts section under AA list your first name as "MY-NAME-IS" and surname as "YOUR-FULL-NAME"
 - 7: Taxi: just in case you have an unexpected drink. Don't Drink & Drive.
 8. The school. No explanation needed!
